## Marc Chabot

Since 1990, Marc Chabot has periodically offered classes in figure drawing, anatomy for artists, as well as etching and monotype classes. 2025 marks his 36th year running the Tuesday Evening Life Drawing Sessions at WAA, and he has recently started offering a second session weekly on Thursday mornings. Marc has also taught at Western Connecticut State University, Wooster Community Art Center, for many years at Weir Farm Historic Site, Flanders Nature Center, where he is curator of founder Natalie Van Vleck's Collections. He was a long-time member of WAA's Exhibition Committee and co-curated WAA's 60th Anniversary Exhibition with Richard Klein, and Natalie Van Vleck: True to her Art Life and Land at the Mattatuck Museum with a 70-pg catalogue. He received his B.S. from Skidmore in Drawing & Printmaking, and worked with Michael Mazur and Hyman Bloom in Boston. In 1990, he founded Marc Chabot Fine Arts, and is a web based private dealer in fine original prints and other works on paper, exhibiting at art fairs up and down the east coast.
